

COVID 19 PREVENTION HEALTH MINISTRY ORDER 12TH AUGUST 2020

PASSENGERS ARRIVING USE FROM CROATIA/GREECE: WHAT TO DO?



Do you have a certificate to demonstrate that in the 72 hours before entering Italy you had a Covid-19 nasal or throat swab test with a negative result?

OK, keep the certificate with you. NO OBLIGATIONS TO COMPLY.



Are you a truck driver at work? OK, NO OBLIGATIONS TO COMPLY.



Do you live in Italy and you are going back home, or are you reaching another destination in Italy?*

Immediately after landing, contact the local heath authority of your home or destination and inform about your arrival;

Go to your destination; stay in self-isolation. The test will be done in 48 hours.



Are you coming from Croatia or Greece to reach a destination OUTSIDE ITALY?* If you leave Italy in 36 hours from your landing, there is no obligation to comply.

Reduce your journey and stopovers as much as possible, and exit Italy in 36 hours.

If you will take more than 36 hours to leave Italy, contact the local heath authority and stay in self-isolation. Test will be done in 48 hours.



Are you coming to Italy for specific and proved needs (work, health, emergencies)?*

If you plan to stay less than 120 hours from your landing there is no obligation to comply.

If you will stay longer, contact the local heath authority and stay in self-isolation.



You landed in port and you have symptoms?

Contact the port or the ship staff for the activation of the Covid protocol. We will immediately take care of you.

^{*} If you travelled in or you departed from the following countries in the last 14 days, you must stay in self-isolation and you must travel to your place of stay only by private transport: Armenia, Australia, Bahrein, Bangladesh, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Georgia, Japan, Kosovo, Kuwait, Montenegro, New Zealand, Northern Macedonia, Moldova, Oman, Panama, Peru, Dominican Republic, Romania, Rwanda, Republic of Korea, Serbia, Thailand, Tunisia, Uruguay.
